



Instructions for Signature Collection

Thank you for your support and your help. In order to get on the ballot, we need 1,790 signatures across all 16 counties in Iowa's 3rd Congressional District. With your help, we can put Pete on the path to victory. Together we can win the future!

Instructions:

- 1) Print off this instruction guide and the attached petition.
- 2) Fill in the County where you will be collecting signatures.
 - a. If you are getting signatures in more than 1 county, you will need separate sheets for each county.
- 3) Have signers fill out all 4 columns on the petition – Name, Address, City, Date.

Eligible Electors

All eligible electors of Iowa's 3rd congressional district may sign nomination petitions. An eligible elector meets all of the requirements to register to vote but does not have to be registered to vote. An eligible elector must:

- Be a citizen of the United States,
- Be a resident of Iowa, and
- Be at least 18 years old.

An eligible elector may not:

- Be a convicted felon (unless voting rights have been restored by the president or governor),
- Be currently judged incompetent to vote by a court, and
- Claim the right to vote in another place

*There is no limit on the number of nomination petitions one elector may sign for different candidates.

Best Practices for Signature Collection

Here are a few simple and effective ways you can get signatures and help put Pete on the ballot:

- 1) **Friends and Family** – Conversations with friends and family can come easily and as long as they are residents of the 3rd Congressional District and eligible voters they can sign a petition for Pete. They don't even have to be registered or a supporter, but we'd appreciate you putting in a good word. If you think you can find 10 to 20 to 30 or more friends and family, this is probably the easiest way to help Pete's signature drive.
- 2) **Your Neighbors** – Know your neighbors or want to get to know them? How about getting them to support the democratic process and sign a petition for Pete. All's you need is nominating petitions, a pen, and a clipboard (or something sturdy to write on). Then just start knocking on doors!
- 3) **Co-Workers or Classmates** – Many of us will spend a good deal of our day at work or in class. If there are gaps in the day, you can approach your co-workers or classmates and explain the signature process and get their John Hancock for Pete! *Note: Please make sure this is ok with your employer/school before doing.*
- 4) **Public Areas** – Go where the people are; this may be the most effective way to get a lot of signatures in a little amount of time. A college campus, a busy main street, a post office sidewalk; these are just a few of the places you'll find people congregating in numbers. Just walk up and ask them politely if they live in one of the surrounding counties in the 3rd and quickly explain the process. It's as easy as that.

IMPORTANT: Always bring along a couple extra nominating petitions where the County is blank. You can fill that section in if you find people outside of the area you're working in; we need signatures from all 16 Counties in the 3rd District – Adams, Adair, Cass, Dallas, Fremont, Guthrie, Madison, Mills, Montgomery, Page, Polk, Pottawattamie, Ringgold, Taylor, Union, and Warren.
